#### **LEGISLATION**

- > 1989: first decree on accredited adoption organisation
  - obligation to keep records
- > 2005: Hague Convention enters into force
  - Central Authority (flemish and French speaking community): centralized follow-up of all intercountry adoption procedures: preparation and screening of PAP's + article 17
  - "complete adoption files" within CA
- > 2012: right of adoptee / obligation to hand over files to CA
  - consultation of adoption file at CA
  - possiblity to request assistance in roots search

#### REQUEST FOR CONSULTATION

- ➤ ADOPTION PRIOR TO 1989 DECREE: private adoption adoption organisation
- > ADOPTION ORGANISATION? MANY DIFFERENT OUTCOMES!
  - > service still exists
  - cooperation with (former) contactperson
  - > archives have been given to CA (voluntary or by judicial order)
  - > or nothing at all....

#### REQUEST FOR CONSULTATION

- > PRIVATE ADOPTION = NO 'adoption' RECORDS KEPT
  - extremely complicated if adoptee has poor relationship with adoptive parents or issues of loyalty
  - > starting point = information on birth certificate
  - > other sources of information?
    - > entry into territory (Department of foreign affairs + Immigration Office)
    - recognition of foreign adoption decision (Belgian courts)
    - national register (national adoption)
- > or nothing at all....

### **ASSISTANCE IN ROOTS SEARCH**

- > ADOPTEE WHO REQUESTS ADDITIONAL INFORMATION or WHO WANTS TO FIND HIS/HER BIOLOGICAL FAMILY
- > CALL FOR ASSISTANCE TO CA
  - > CA in country of origin
  - accredited adoption organisation
  - independent social workers
  - > ISS
- > real challenges
  - > rules and regulations in country of origin
  - available information
  - COSTS

#### STRENGHTS AND WEAKNESSES?

- > ACCESS TO ORIGINS is SHARED RESPONSABILITY
  - > CA is not only actor, nor the best "equipped" (in some cases)
  - infomation and expertise is often scattererd
- ACCESS TO ORIGINS is MORE THAN KNOWING AND FINDING
  - counselling is no luxury (psycho-social)
  - closely related or maybe intertwined with the practical process

REAL NEED FOR integrated approach (adoptee's perspective) AND pooling of means, knowlegde and expertise

# NEW APPROACH CENTER FOR ORIGINS

### HISTORY OF FORCED ADOPTIONS

- > Belgium, mid '60 tot mid '80
- > NO information on birth certificate, in case of "accouchement sous X in France"
- NO real possibilities for adoptee to find biological parents?
  - > churches and homes for unmarried mother handed over archives
  - = similar to problems with private adoptions!!!
  - > "expert panel" advise

#### **CENTER FOR ORIGINS**

- any person with questions about his or her origins (for whom legal ancestry does not correspond to biological or social reality)
- > OPEN DEFINITION target group (adoptees, donor children, foundlings)
  - > information
  - assistance in search for relatives
    - consultation of files
    - > search
    - DNA-matching
    - contact
  - psychosocial guidance and counselling

#### **CENTER FOR ORIGINS**

#### COUNSELLING

- independent, SPECIALISED service with experience in field of family mediation, adoption and/or donor conception
- guidance, consultation, assistance in 'finding'
- open to everyone

#### **DNA-MATCHING**

- in cooperation with CENTER FOR GENETIC RESEARCH
- voluntary basis
- DNA-profile and matching for specific groups, TARGETED

## ROOTS SEARCH... NO WALK IN THE PARK?!

- > no guarantees as to the outcome!
